DESCRIPTION

The Kankakee County Soil & Water Conservation District is seeking candidates for a part-time spring internship position, effective January through the end of the 2018-2019 academic year (April-May). It is preferred that the candidate has earned or is working towards earning a degree within education or the agricultural, environmental, or biological sciences. It is preferred that the candidate have a background in agriculture, or some knowledge pertaining to the agricultural industry.

The Kankakee County SWCD plans and implements programs for conservation and educational purposes in Kankakee County. The intern will be working with the county's Resource Conservationist to complete work in the District office, with occasional visits to the field.

Pay: \$10-12/hour

Hours are dependent upon hired intern's availability, but a consistent weekly schedule will be established upon hire.

BASIC SKILLS

Candidates must have the ability to communicate across all levels, be organized, self-motivated, willing to accept responsibility, willing to adapt, able to take constructive criticism, and possess excellent oral and written communication skills. Candidates must have good interpersonal skills and be willing to work with others while maintaining a positive attitude.

Computer skills are required. Additional on-the-job training will be offered as needed.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

The Kankakee County SWCD spring intern may be responsible for the following:

- Providing technical and administrative assistance for the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS).
- Assisting with the completion of Natural Resource Information (NRI) reports for the Kankakee County Regional Planning Department, if needed.
- Researching and organizing grant opportunities and partnerships for the District.
- Planning and executing new and ongoing District programs, projects, and educational grants.
- Maintaining and improving the Kankakee County SWCD website and social media accounts.
- Assisting the Resource Conservationist with daily office tasks, sales, data entry, promotion of District programs and events, educational outreach opportunities, and field work.
